HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE MAN

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Performs a variety of tasks in connection with the construction, repair, and maintenance of highways; does related work, as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only)

Participates in the construction and maintenance of rights of way;

Participates in the construction and erection of safety barriers;

Participates in the spreading and leveling of asphalt, stone products, gravel, and other road-building materials;

Removes obstructions and debris from roadways;

Assists in snow-removal operations, when weather conditions preclude performing highway maintenance tasks.

The above examples of duties are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work performed. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related or a logical assignment to the position.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES, AND/OR PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Working knowledge of road construction and maintenance practices; working knowledge of the use of various tools, equipment, and terminology of the trade; ability to follow oral and written instructions; ability to procure appropriate motor vehicle operator's license; willingness to work out-of-doors, under adverse weather conditions; physical strength and endurance; reliability; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the job.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: None is required.
