WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT OPERATOR (HELP Program)

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:</u> This is routine but important work involving responsibility during a shift for the efficient operation and maintenance of a Wastewater Treatment Plant with facilities for chemical precipitation, sludge vacuum filtration, sludge incineration, separate sludge digestion, or any other biological oxidation process other than the activated sludge and the stabilization or oxidation process. The work is performed under the general supervision of an operator qualified to be in charge of the operation of the plant. Supervision may be exercised over subordinate employees n the performance of their assigned duties. May perform activities related to the Industrial Pretreatment Program under general supervision. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Starts and stops pumps, motors, air compressors, and related machinery and equipment;

Makes minor repairs to machinery and equipment;

Records readings from meters and gauges;

Treats and disposes of sludge;

Operates trickling filters;

Adds chlorine to wastewater;

Takes samples of wastewater for testing;

Makes necessary tests for control of plant operation;

Assists in the instruction of trainees;

Supervises the work of laborers and other subordinate employees;

Keeps a log of plant operations and related records;

Performs custodial duties in connection with maintenance of buildings and grounds;

May maintain records, generate reports and correspondence concerning the Industrial Pretreatment Program.

The above example of duties is intended only as illustrations of the various types of work to be performed. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related or a logical assignment to the position.

ETULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND/OR PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Good knowledge of the practices used and the equipment required in the operation and maintenance of a Wastewater Treatment Plant with facilities for chemical precipitation, sludge vacuum filtration, sludge incineration, sludge oxidation, separate sludge digestion, or any other biological oxidation process other than the activated sludge and the stabilization or oxidation pond process; working knowledge of the principles and application of physics, chemistry and bacteriology as applied to wastewater treatment and disposal; skill in the operation and repair of pumps, valves, and related mechanical and electrical equipment; ability to read, understand and record data from gauges, scales, and meters; ability to make routine laboratory and field tests for control of plant operations; ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions; ability to communicate both orally and in writing with customers and regulatory agencies; mechanical aptitude; alertness and dependability; good physical condition commensurate with the demands of the job.

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MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Wastewater Treatment Plant whose designated Plant Point Score is 56-75 points.
 Possession of a high school diploma or an equivalency diploma recognized by the New York State Department of Education AND completion of an appropriate course of instruction approved by the Commissioner, Department of Conservation AND twelve months operating experience at a Wastewater Treatment Plant with a point score of 31 or greater and the ability to perform necessary tests.
- 2. Wastewater Treatment Plant whose designated Plant point Score is 55 points or less. Possession of a high school diploma or an equivalency diploma recognized by the New York State Department of Education AND completion of an appropriate course of instruction approved by the Commissioner, department of Conservation AND six months operating experience at a Wastewater Treatment Plant and the ability to perform necessary tests.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT FOR ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS:

- 1. Wastewater Treatment Plant whose designated Plant Point Score is 56-75 points. Eligibility for a Grade 2A certificate issued under the provisions of the New York State Sanitary Code. Possession of a certificate at the time of appointment.
- 2. Wastewater Treatment Plant whose designated Plant Point Score is 55 points or less. Eligibility for a Grade 1A certificate issued under the provisions of the New York Sate Sanitary Code. Possession of the certificate at the time of appointment.
