## COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE GENESEE COUNTY LEGISLATURE WEDNESDAY, MARCH 24, 2021 OLD COURTHOUSE LEGISLATIVE CHAMBERS & ZOOM VIDEO CONFERENCE

The Genesee County Legislature met on Wednesday, March 24, 2021 at 4:30 PM in the Legislative Chambers at the Old Courthouse and using Zoom videoconference.

Legislature Chair Stein called the meeting to order at 4:30 PM for a discussion regarding the continuation of meeting remotely. The executive order suspending the open meetings law is set to end March 26<sup>th</sup> however it is possible the executive order will be extended.

When the executive order does end, if the legislature wishes to continue to meet remotely and count toward a quorum and vote, rules must be adopted to ensure required aspects of the open meetings law are followed.

Legislators expressed their intention to attend meetings in person but would like to continue to offer the opportunity for people to listen and watch committee and legislature meetings. County Attorney Kevin Earl stated no action was required by the legislature.
