FROM THE NORTH. Take Rt. 33 West to Rt. 5 East. Turn left on Rt. 5. Turn right onto Townline Road. Townline Road becomes Bethany Center Road. Turn left into the Park entrance and continue along the road to the Center.

FROM THE WEST: Take Rt. 20 East to Bethany Center. Turn left onto Old Telephone Road and then right onto Bethany Center Road. Turn left into the Park entrance and continue along the road to the Center.


FROM THE EAST: Take Rt. 20 West to Bethany Center. Turn right onto Old Telephone Road and then left onto Bethany Center Road. Turn left into the Park entrance and continue along the road to the Center.
