

# GENESEE COUNTY WATER SUPPLY PROJECT: UPCOMING PHASE 3 PROJECTS January 2024

The subprojects listed below are several candidates to be constructed early on in Phase 3 of the Countywide Water Supply Project. Phase 3 has a total of 11 subprojects that include transmission mains, water storage tanks, pump stations, and water quality improvements to convey an additional 7.6 Million gallon per day (MGD) to Genesee County.

#### North Road Water Storage Tank

- <u>Location:</u> LeRoy, New York (adjacent to existing North Road Pump Station)
- <u>Project Description</u>: Construction of a new 1.0 million gallon ground level water storage tank to provide redundancy in storage, firefighting response, and stabilize pressures at the North Road Pump Station.
- <u>Cost:</u> **\$4,640,000**
- <u>Grants:</u> \$2,000,000 award (FY23 Congressionally Directed Spending Request)

## Golden Road Transmission Main and Pump Station Upgrades

- Location: Chili/Gates, New York
- <u>Project Description</u>: Installation of a new 36" transmission main, approximately 30,000 linear feet in length. This large main will have a 13.6 MGD capacity.
- <u>Cost:</u> **\$21,848,000**
- Grants: None

## Stottle Road Transmission Main

- Location: Chili, New York
- <u>Project Description</u>: Installation of a new 30" transmission main approximately 19,000 linear feet in length and convey an additional 4.61 MGD.
- <u>Cost:</u> **\$13,444,000**
- Grants: None

#### Macomber Road and Galloway Road Water Main

- <u>Location:</u> Town of Batavia, New York
- <u>Project Description</u>: Installation of approximately 11,300 linear feet of 12" PVC water main along Galloway Rd. and approximately 3,400 linear feet of 8" PVC water main along Macomber Rd.
- <u>Cost:</u> **\$2,522,000**
- Grants: None
