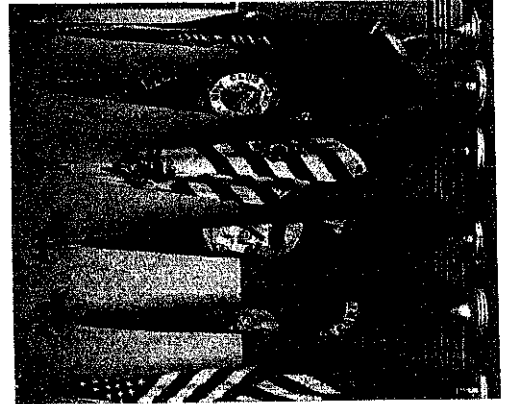
### Preamble

*United States of America and fidelity to its Constitution.*

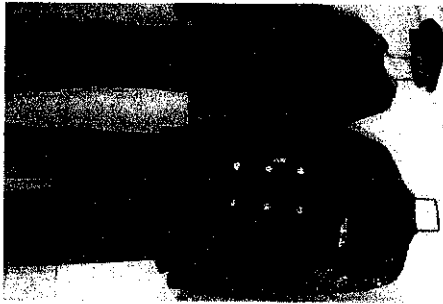
