County Attorney James Wujcik reported the County has imposed an additional one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) local tax on mortgages for real property situated within the County of Genesee in addition to the tax imposed on said mortgages with the local tax of one-quarter of one percent to be used for the purpose of offsetting expenses of the Recording/County Clerk's Office. Requested legislation for authorization for such additional mortgage tax and requested New York State Legislature to support the legislation necessary to continue a one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) increase in Genesee County's mortgage tax rate. This was approved for placement on the next Legislature Agenda upon motion of Legislator Maha seconded by Legislator Deleo, carried unanimously

County Attorney James Wujcik requested State Legislation authorizing Genesee County to continue its imposition of an additional one percent 1% Local Sales Tax expires on November 30, 2023. Requested to introduce to Legislation authorizing Genesee County to renew the additional one percent (1%) Sales Tax through November 30, 2026. This was approved for placement on the next Legislature Agenda upon motion of Legislator Torrey seconded by Legislator Deleo, carried unanimously

County Attorney James Wujcik requested an amendment to the 2023 County Budget due to a shortage of funds in his claims account. There is sufficient money in the Casualty Liability Insurance Reserve to cover this shortfall. Requested authorization to amend the 2023 Budget by adjusting the County Attorney Appropriations and Revenues by the following amounts: Increase in revenue \$90,000 to be offset by an increase in expense Claims \$90,000. This was approved for placement on the next Legislature Agenda upon motion of Legislator Maha seconded by Legislator Torrey, carried unanimously
